ASCENTS

CERRO SOLO 2121 MTS. - GLACIAR ASCENT

This program is design for those who want to achieve an ascent in one of the satellite peaks around Fitz Roy and Torre Massifs, in the Glaciers National Park. We have chosen Cerro Solo for its characteristics and beauty, as well as for its location that permits a unique view of the whole area. Ascents are organized from our headquarters; we check the equipment, choose the guides and accord day, time and place of meeting with the passengers.

TRIP DETAILS

Los Glaciares national Park. El Chalten area  
 October thru April  
 3 dias / 2 nights  
 Minimum 1 pax and maximum 3 pax each guide  
 Camp- expedition

DIFFICULTY GRADE

RECOMMENDED PERSONAL GEAR



This glacier ascent is very physical and technically demanding. We will overnight in a camp at an intermediate height, and we will build a snow cave. For this, we ask to accredit previous experience in mountain activities and in the use of crampons, or having done, at least an intermediate Ice Clinic.

ITINERARY

Day 1 | El Chaltén – Camp Thorwood

Departure from El Chalten walking along the Fitz Roy River to the west up to Thorwood Camp, nearby Laguna Torre. Distance: 10 km – 2 hours of walk. Practice of Basic Glacier Expedition Techniques. Camp in height. CHT-Thorwood Drop in ascent: 200m. Thorwood-Camp in height: 950m  
 BL, D... Camp... Mountain Guide

Day 2 | Thorwood Camp – Vivac in height

Trek up to the foot of the glacier . Practice of Basic Glacier Expedition Techniques. Camp in height. Thorwood-Camp in height; drop in ascent: 950m  
 B, BL, D... Mountain Guide

Day 3|Summit and return to Chalten

Glacier ascent. Descent. Trek back to El Chalten. End of services. Camp in height – Summit: Drop in ascent: 520m  
 B, BL... Mountain Guide

Included

- Mountain Guide, licensed by the National Park Administration
  - Radio communication with our offices in El Chaltén. Technical equipment required for mountain activities (crampons, harness, carabiners, ice axes, ropes, etc.)
  - Double tents, kitchen equipment and crockery.
  - Accommodation: see detail in the itinerary
  - Meals: see detail in the itinerary
- B: Breakfast  
 BL: Box Lunch  
 D: Dinner

Not Included

- Personal Equipment.
- Transfers in/out El Chaltén.
- Drinks in restaurant
- Tips.
